If he gave out open-book reading quizzes, that would give us an opportunity to understand the material better.

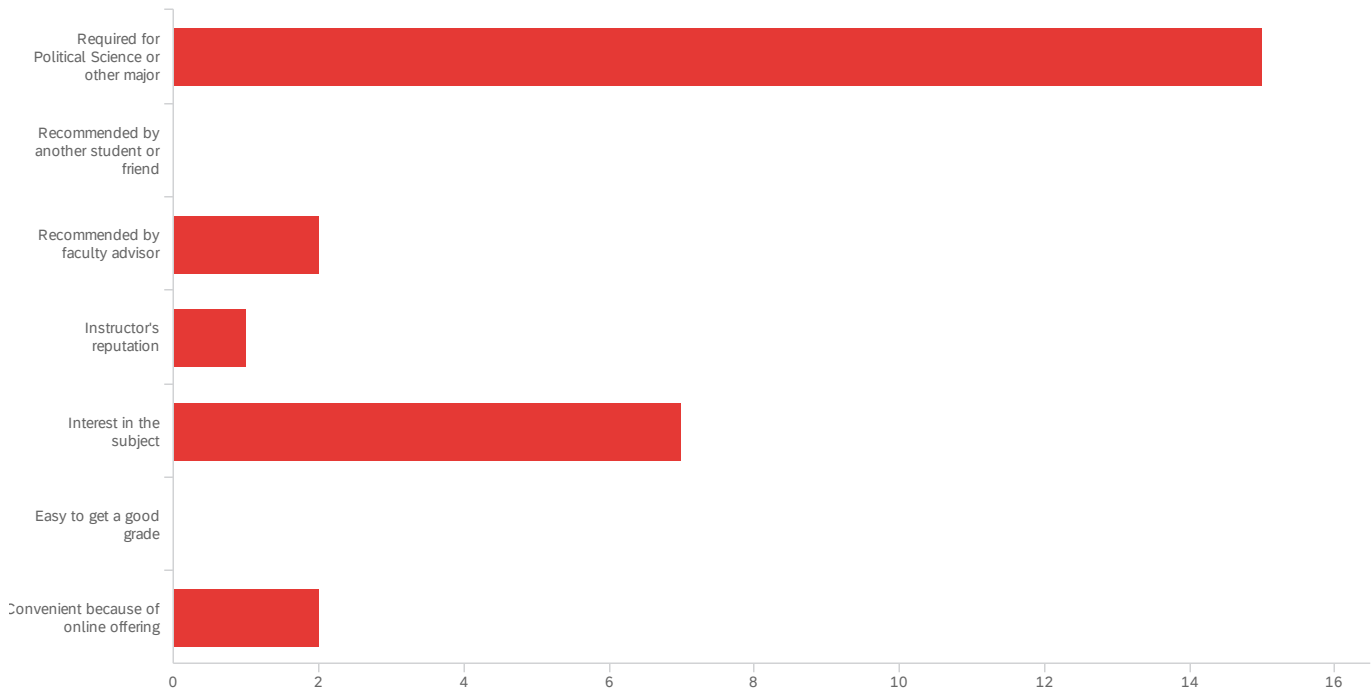

Maybe more small grades such as a couple of quizzes (as in the student can choose which weeks to take a quiz for a total of 3 quizzes - one from each section)

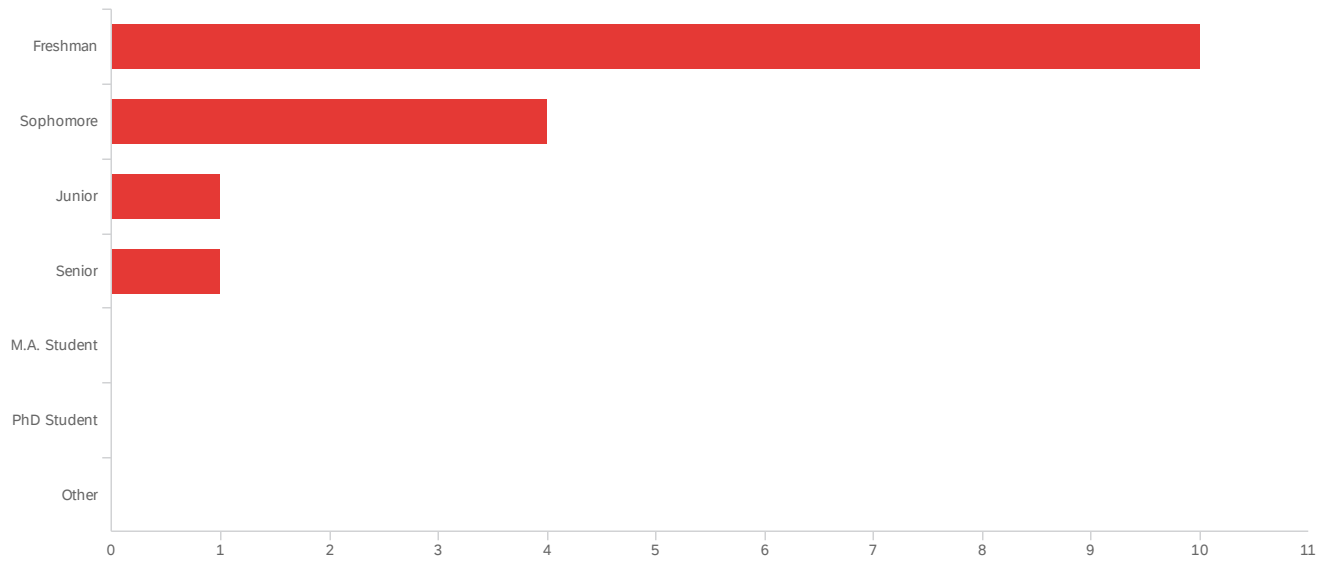

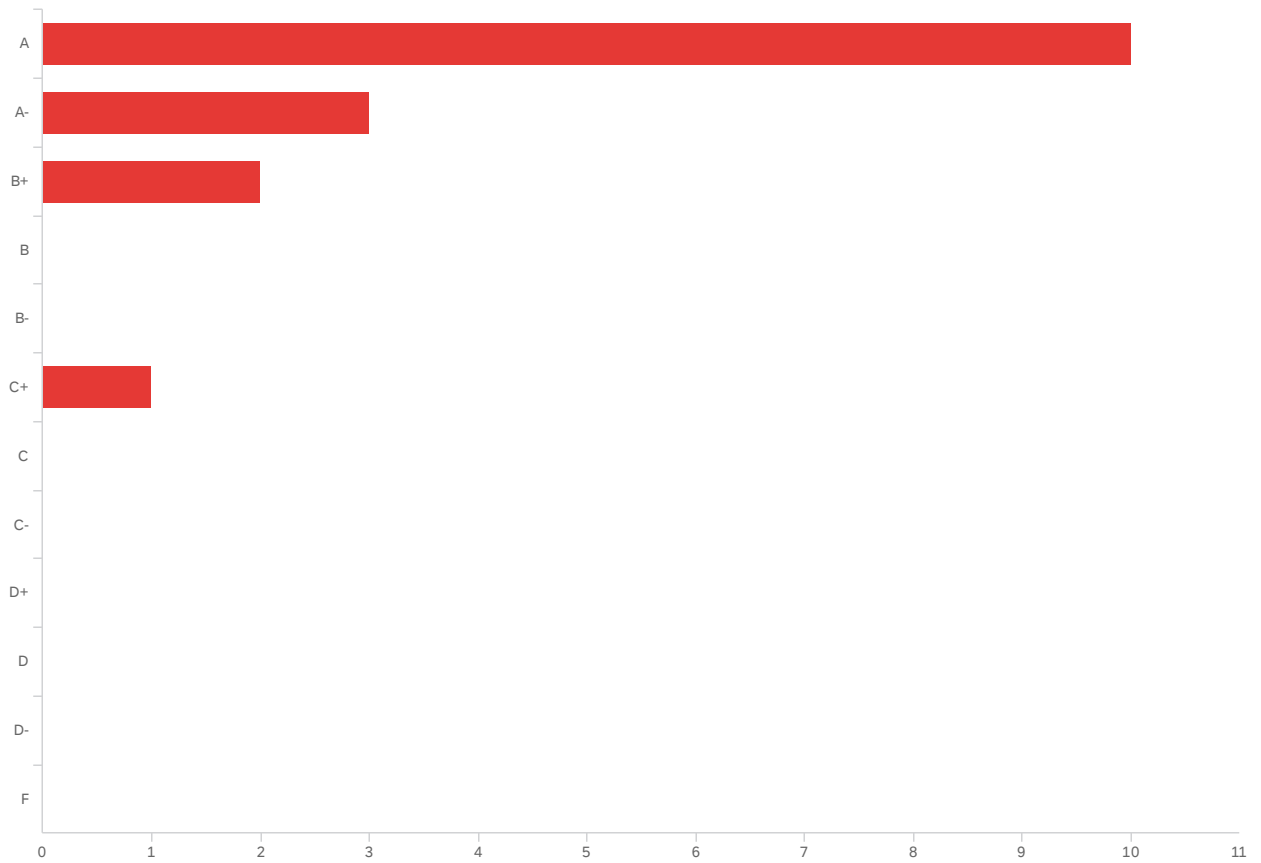
